Graduation Ceremony

The Class of 2019 will graduate on Tuesday, June 11th at 6:00pm at KEN STRONG STADIUM

- ◆ Graduates must arrive **to the auditorium** no later than 5:15pm in order to prepare for the ceremony.
- ◆ All seating for parents and guests is general admission WITH A TICKET.
- ◆ In the event of inclement weather, graduation will take place in the Edward L. Bennett Rink.
- ◆ After the ceremony, members of the graduation committee will issue diplomas from the gymnasium.
- ◆ **Per order of the Fire Marshall, all stairwells, aisles, and walkways must be kept clear.**

Distribution of cap and gown and tickets to all seniors in good standing will take place at these rehearsals.

All graduating seniors must attend all rehearsals.

Tickets

No one will be allowed into the graduation ceremony without a ticket. Each graduate will receive eight **BLUE graduation tickets** which can be used for the outdoor graduation ceremony. Seating is first come, first served. The **three YELLOW tickets may be used for the indoor ceremony in the event of inclement weather. Students may request ONE additional indoor ticket at the second practice if needed. No more than one additional ticket will be given per person due to stadium capacity.**

FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS

Graduation tickets, caps & gowns, and diplomas will be withheld from seniors who have outstanding fees, bills, or fines (replacement ID's, library books, textbooks, athletic equipment, uniforms, etc.). **All financial obligations must be settled by June 3rd, 2019.** See Mrs. Corrado in D119, Mrs. Orio in the Main office or Mrs. Paredes.

All seniors are invited to a substance-free up-all-night graduation celebration after graduation. This event is **FREE FOR SENIORS!** Students must board busses directly after the ceremony. Students may not drive to the event.
